The Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals just issued a stay of construction on the eight miles within the City of Green pending COG's appeal of the 401 Water Quality Permit. In another similar action, yesterday David Mucklow and Aaron Ridenbaugh filed a Motion with Judge Adams attempting to halt the eminent domain case in federal court so that the rehearing process at FERC and possibly the Court of Appeals, can be completed before issues become moot.

David and Aaron are asking the Court (and by the rehearing request with FERC) to address the legal issue of whether the Natural Gas Act (NGA) allows NEXUS to use eminent domain to build an export pipeline. While many, approximately seven, rehearing requests on NEXUS are pending before FERC, NEXUS has forged ahead with this eminent domain case.
