INTRODUCED: JUNE 28, 2022 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE POLICING CONTRACT (FISCAL YEARS 2021-2023) WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF TO INCLUDE A K-9 UNIT TO PROVIDE SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF GREEN, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in November 2020, the City approved Resolution 2020-R78, entering into a three-year (3) Contract with the Summit County Sheriff to provide policing service; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the public's health, safety, and welfare to add one (1) K-9 unit to provide services within the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green's budget requires a modification of appropriations in order to provide sufficient funds; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the reason that the existing Contract with the Summit County Sheriff does not include a K-9 Unit. In authorizing this Amendment to the Policing Contract, the City will be able to include a K-9 Unit to the provide services to the City. This is the reason why second (2<sup>nd</sup>) reading passage is requested on June 28, 2022.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

#### **SECTION ONE:**

Green City Council authorizes and approves the First Amendment to the Policing Contract between the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff. A copy of the First Amendment to the Policing Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein to this legislation as Exhibit "A."

## **SECTION TWO:**

The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the sum of Seventy-One Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Six Dollars and Eighty-One Cents (\$71,646.81) to the Sheriff Contract Account (Acct #100-3000-52415) from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund.

#### **SECTION THREE:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

### **SECTION FOUR:**

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation

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of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the K-9 unit shall begin providing services to the City no later than September 1, 2022. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
