A RESOLUTION AWARDDING A CONTRACT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE 2019 RESURFACING PROJECT, MAKING A TRANSFER, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, January 31, 2019; and, Thursday, February 7, 2019, for the 2019 Resurfacing Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on Friday, February 15, 2019, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Northstar Asphalt, Inc. as the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project in the amount of ~~One Million Five Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars and Ninety Five Cents (\$1,548,887.95)~~ **One Million Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$1,755,339.85)**; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds to pay for the costs of the project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the general laws of the State of Ohio and OAS Bulletin 1997-03 on interfund advances, it is necessary to reallocate cash from the General Fund to the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on February 15, 2019:

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Northstar Asphalt, Inc. with its total base bid plus alternate bids No. 1, ~~No. 2~~ & No. 4 of ~~One Million Five Hundred Forty Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars and Ninety Five Cents (\$1,548,887.95)~~ *One Million Seven Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$1,755,339.85)*, is the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the Project. *Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to the Various Resurfacing of Roads Account (Acct #201-2100-53630), from the unappropriated balance of Street Construction and Maintenance Fund for the 2019 Resurfacing Project.* Green City Council further authorizes the Finance Director to make payments to Northstar Asphalt, Inc. through the established purchase order procedure.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council approves the transfer of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the General Fund to the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund in order to provide adequate funding for the 2019 Resurfacing Project.

SECTION FOUR FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE SIX:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the Project may proceed immediately and forthwith. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
