I am only 48, I hope I have time as this is very near and dear to me and probably very silly that I never knew cemeteries could fill up. Maybe no one else knew this? I really think until you need this it is an afterthought and something no one really thinks of.

If space is not available in the current locations is there space for a third active Cemetery in Green. I really feel like time is of the essence, tomorrow is never promised and I would like to do my preplanning with Green as my final. I am only guessing but I am sure many other citizens would like to be here in Green as well.
