A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FOR NATUREWORKS PROGRAM FUNDING AS ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE OF OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR SHADE STRUCTURES AT CENTRAL PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources ("ODNR"), administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program for the purchase and installation of shade structures at Central Park; and

WHEREAS, the ODNR Grant is a reimbursement grant of up to seventy-five percent (75%), which would improve the public recreation at Central Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to file an application for the NatureWorks Grant Fund programmed by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the purchase and installation of shade structures within Central Park and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council agrees to obligate the funds required from the Parks Capital Projects Fund (Fund 402) to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Grant Program if funds are awarded.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
