**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO B&B SEALING, LLC, DBA DURA SEAL, FOR THE 2018 PARKS PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, February 15, 2018; and, Thursday, February 22, 2018, for the 2018 Parks Pavement Maintenance (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on Monday, March 5, 2018, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to B&B Sealing, LLC, DBA Dura Seal, as the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project in the amount of \$90,029.74.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION TWO:**

City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that B&B Sealing, LLC, DBA Dura Seal, with its base bid plus alternate bids one, four, and five of \$90,029.74, is the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

**SECTION THREE:**

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with B&B Sealing, LLC, DBA Dura Seal, for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to B&B Sealing, LLC, DBA Dura Seal, through the established purchase order procedures.

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FIVE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that this Project may move forward immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
