I seen in the paper that you had opened up bids for trash removal. I am a council member for the Village of Lakemore and used to live in Green. Even though I no longer live there I still have ties to the community and my daughter still goes to Green H.S. I can't tell you what you should do but I can tell you how many complaints we received about our trash service with Republic. Namely that trash and recycling is not picked up and when our Village Administrator calls and asks why she is always told that the truck broke down but they do not send out a replacement truck and the trash sits till the following week. The other thing you may want to investigate is what materials they accept for recycling. For us it is only plastics. I know Kimble does paper/cardboard and glass along with the plastics. You may be paying less but you are getting a lower standard of service and you will get more complaints from your constituents. Our contract with Republic ends in 2022 and we are counting down the days till it is over. While I have no dog in the fight I hope you can at least see I still want what is best for my friends that still live there and to save you from future headaches. My husband and I live on Ridgedale Drive. We would like to express our opinions about changing trash service companies. We lived here years ago when Republic provided the service here in Green. We also own a rental property in Barberton. We were less than satisfied with Republic as our own carrier and our renters in Barberton have expressed numerous times how unhappy they were with Republic's services. They said that the trash was never picked up on the day it was scheduled to be picked up. They left a mess and charged many "extras" as well. Barberton has recently changed carriers and the renters are much happier with their new Kimble service.

We, too, are very pleased with our Kimble service here in Green. We do not want Republic back as our service provider. I also remember several times this winter seeing on the news that Republic would not be picking up that day due to inclement weather. Kimble has never delayed service due to weather. Kimble's trucks operate on Natural Gas also which is better for our environment. The trucks have cleaner emissions and run quieter.

If you have not already done so, you should take a look at the Facebook post in the City of Green Group regarding the trash provider contract. It is eye-opening to see that there is not even one post in the whole thing favorable to Republic. Every post is asking council to KEEP KIMBLE. This is a testament to their great service. Many also commented that they would rather pay the extra dollar a month to keep Kimble. We think that the citizens of Green should have a say in this because WE are the ones paying for it. If the residents want to keep Kimble because of better service, then their voices should be heard and followed even if Kimble costs slightly more. Again, this is OUR service and WE are paying for it. Our representatives should be listening to us. This contract being for an extended time period is also good reason to go with the superior service of Kimble vs. the inferior service and additional costs of Republic. It's too long to have to be unhappy with a provider that doesn't live up to expectations.

When you ran for office to represent the people in our city , it was our expectation that you would listen to our concerns and opinions. We trust that you will make good on that expectation. Here is your chance to prove it. We want to keep Kimble as our service provider. Please express our voice to council members and vote in favor of Kimble.

Dear City of Green Council,

I have seen an article regarding The City of Green and consideration for trash vendors. I wanted to share as a consumer my experience with our current supplier and with Republic that serves much of Akron including my parents home. I also wish to share as a consumer what is important to me when it comes to trash but more so to recycling. I am going to speak backwards on my topics but these are the two areas I wish to share food for thought.

As a consumer and one who has lived abroad where the trash system is, frankly speaking, more regulated. The city provided a calendar where in different days they collected different items. Once per month was glass in the glass bin. Another day or about twice per month was paper recycling. Every week was what they called valorux which was cans, tetra packs, plastics et al. Then there was trash day weekly. We had a very small bin and our bin had a bar code on it. The trucks have a scale. They put the bin on the truck and as it is emptying the bin it reads the weight and bar code and we were charged ultimately by the weight of our true waste. Although a more regulated system, it forced you to get really good at recycling. Upon return some 10 years now, we have remained really good at recycling. Our recycling bin is full weekly and yet it is collected every other week. Our current company allows us to use the extra yellow open top square bins. We regularly use this for our cardboard, broken down. The best part of our current supplier is that we can use bags to put our recycled products into rather than have messy cans inside the home. This beyond all is the greatest convenience to me as a consumer. I don't have time to clean my indoor - kitchen recycling bin weekly because I am not allowed to use a recycling bag.

Now let me share my experience with Republic and Akron service. Although they pick up bins just like everyone else, their recycling options are limited and my parents bin is filthy from not being able to use bags and there are no options for extra recycling bins at will. The extra items that get placed outside a regular trash bin also can not just be placed there as the customer has to call and schedule for the 3 extra bill items that they wish to have next to their bin. I have recently liquidated the contents of my parents home and the trash process has been very inconvenient and limiting. Their services is never what I would choose to have at my home. As a consumer with a crazy busy life, I want the most convenient and easy trash provider. I don't want to "think" or "manage" our household waste or recycling.

Those are my thoughts as a consumer and from someone who has lived a whole different system. At the end of the day I wish we could have a pay what you waste system like we experienced in Luxembourg and yet I would tweak their system to be an easier recycling system and add the weigh the trash and pay based upon trash. So my system would be a hybrid of what we have now and the Luxembourg weight the can and pay for actual waste.

I hope you receive this in the context it is intended, to provide a perspective of a consumer who has experienced a few systems and one who does not want to have to think or be limited by her trash company.

I wish you the very best and hope you all stay safe. I also thank you as a resident for your continued dedication to the city. I know the work is never ending.

I recently learned that the Council will be deliberating over the City's trash service.

We have been very satisfied with the service provided by Kimble since we moved here in 2011. They have always been prompt and reliable.

I would gladly pay \$1 more per month and forego the two additional recycling pickups in order to maintain the quality of service that I am currently receiving.

Friends in communities that use Republic are not at all happy with their trash removal. They use older trucks that frequently break down causing disruptions in service. Republic also will only recycle plastic. I would prefer to remain with a company that also takes glass, cardboard and cans.
