Subject: Update: Well Testing

Nexus' "Free" Well testing for those within 500 feet of the line does not include complex testing for VOC Contaminates from HDD drilling. If you live near Nimisila Reservoir where HDD drilling is scheduled, you should consider getting a Tier 3 Complex VOC Test before and after construction. You need a before baseline test if you ever have to go to court to prove contamination. Donamarc, a reputable local company, can do the VOC tests. Again, legal drill fluid should not contain these contaminants, but in Stark County they found that Rover's drilling fluid had illegal chemical additives in it.

If you are not near the HDD drilling at Nimisila, but are still close to other areas of construction, consult with Donamarc. He's recommending a less expensive basic test in case ground water bacteria seeps into the water table during dry drilling.
