

**SECOND AMENDMENT
TO
POLICING CONTRACT
BETWEEN
COUNTY OF SUMMIT, SHERIFF OF SUMMIT COUNTY
AND CITY OF GREEN**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE POLICING CONTRACT is dated as of the date signed by the County Executive by and among the County of Summit, Ohio (hereinafter "County"), the Sheriff of Summit County, Ohio ("Sheriff") and the City of Green, Ohio (hereinafter "Political Subdivision").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Policing Contract, commencing on January 1, 2024 (hereinafter "Contract"), as authorized by County Council Resolution No. 2023-313 and a Supplemental Agreement, as authorized by County Council Resolution No. 2025-023; and

WHEREAS, the Policing Contract at Paragraph 10 provides that upon mutual written consent of all the parties, the contract may be modified; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure proper coverage the County has added the Political Subdivision as an additional insured to its insurance policy for incidents occurring under the aforementioned Contract.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein and intending to be legally bound, the parties agree to amend Paragraph 8 the Contract as follows:

8. Insurance and Legal Representation. The County will list the Political Subdivision as an additional insured for claims relating to County employees acting within the scope of their employment under this Contract. The County does not waive any protections, including immunity, provided by state and federal law and shall retain all rights to legal representation by the County's Prosecutor's Office in accordance with all laws, including but not limited to Ohio Revised Code §309.09.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract entered into between the parties on January 29, 2024, (original Contract date) and Supplemental Agreement to the Policing Contract shall continue in full force and effect.
