INTRODUCED: DECEMBER 13, 2022 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KLEINFELDER, INC. (POGGEMEYER DESIGN GROUP), FOR CONSULTING SERVICES TO UPDATE THE CITY OF GREEN COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (FKA LONG RANGE LAND USE PLAN), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green Comprehensive Plan is a document that identifies and recommends development policies in order to sustain economic and community growth; and

WHEREAS, the first City of Green comprehensive plan was adopted in 1997, updated in 2004 and 2014 and the current recommendation is that this plan be re-evaluated approximately every five years in order to refine policies and evaluate progress; and

WHEREAS, the administration, through a Request for Proposals process, evaluated seven (7) proposals and interviewed four (4) planning consultant firms; and

WHEREAS, the recommendation of the review committee is to enter into a contract for consulting services pertaining to the City of Green Comprehensive Plan with Kleinfelder, Inc. (Poggemeyer Design Group).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council finds that Kleinfelder, Inc. (Poggemeyer Design Group), with its cost proposal of Eighty-Eight Thousand Fifty-Three Dollars (\$88,053.00) is qualified to assist the Planning Department and Planning & Zoning Commission in updating the city's comprehensive plan. Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Contract between the City of Green and Kleinfelder, Inc. (Poggemeyer Design Group) for planning services, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit A".

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payments to Kleinfelder, Inc. (Poggemeyer Design Group) for planning services through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the deadline can be met. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members
