A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ACCEPT A GRANT UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE CITY TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A VEHICLE EXHAUST REMOVAL SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green applied for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant ("Grant") for the purchase and installation of a new Vehicle Exhaust Removal System; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green has been awarded the Grant in the total amount of Forty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents (\$46,813.63); and

WHEREAS, the matching local share not to exceed ten percent (10%); and

WHEREAS, the City will use the Grant to purchase a new Vehicle Exhaust Removal System totaling Fifty-One Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$51,495.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Green accepts the Grant in accordance with the agreement terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes and directs the Mayor to accept the Fiscal Year 2018 Assistance to Firefighters Grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security the in the amount of Forty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents (\$46,813.63). The City's portion of the Grant totals Four Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-One Dollars and Thirty-Seven Cents (\$4,681.37).

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution was taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action was in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
