INTRODUCED: NOVEMBER 10, 2025 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN SERVICE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT SURPLUS PROPERTY TO BE TRADED IN TO OFFSET A PORTION OF THE PURCHASE PRICE FOR A REPLACEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City's Service Director in consultation with the City's Parks Supervisor has determined that the City's existing 2016 Jacobsen R311T (wide-area mower) is obsolete and no longer useful to the City; and

WHEREAS, due to the above determination there is a need to replace the obsolete wide-area mower and purchase a new mower for use by the Service Department to perform mowing jobs in the City; and

WHEREAS, a commercial mower replacement was authorized in the 2025 Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, at this time the City wishes to authorize the trade-in of the City's obsolete wide-area mower to offset a portion of the purchase price for a new mower as detailed in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the administration is requesting first reading passage so as to complete the purchase within the quote timeframe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The following equipment of the City's Service Department is hereby declared surplus municipal property, no longer of useful service to the City:

1. 2016 Jacobsen R311T (Serial # 6917801906)

SECTION TWO:

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sell and trade-in the equipment listed in Section One herein to Baker Vehicle Systems Inc. and receive a credit in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) to apply to the purchase of a Hustler EXC – X-Ride 60" mower as shown on Exhibit A. Green City Council further authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to Baker Vehicle Systems Inc. for equipment through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation
