INTRODUCED: NOVEMBER 27, 2018 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PORTS PETROLEUM CO. INC., TO SUPPLY FUEL TO THE CITY WITHOUT COMPETITVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has fuel storage tanks at Fire Station #1, the S. Annex and the Parks Garage, which routinely purchase both unleaded and diesel fuel; and

WHEREAS, the City has been a long-time customer of Ports Petroleum Co., Inc., and has their monitoring fuel system on both the Fire Station #1 and the S. Annex fuel tank pumps that provide an automatic alert when fuel is low; and

WHEREAS, the Ports Petroleum Co., Inc., has recently lost the competitive supplier bid with the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Procurement Services; and

WHEREAS, Ports Petroleum Co. Inc., has agreed to provide fuel at the same, or lower, price of the current bid award, as well as meet all the terms and condition of the State of Ohio Procurement awarded contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement with Ports Petroleum Co. Inc., for the purchase of unleaded and diesel fuel for the City, per the agreement incorporated herein as Exhibit "A", and further authorizes the purchase of fuel without the formal bidding process set forth in Chapter 210 of Green's Codified Ordinances.

SECTION TWO:

City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to Ports Petroleum Co., Inc. for supplying fuel provided through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

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SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that this project may move forward immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
