A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR THE PRESENTATION OF THE ADMINISTRATION'S EMERGENCY SERVICES STUDY AND PLAN UNTIL SEPTEMBER 8, 2020, DUE TO THE COVID-19 CRISIS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2019, Green City Council passed Ordinance 2019-08 to appropriate Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) from the Pipeline Settlement Fund to study, design, and implement a plan to improve safety services and emergency response times in the southwest quadrant of the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, as part of said Ordinance, the Mayor of the City of Green was authorized to prepare an emergency services study and plan to be presented to Green City Council within one (1) year of the effective date of the legislation; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the COVID-19 Crisis, the City of Green resources and personnel were reassigned to respond to COVID-19, and the City's administration has not had the opportunity to fully complete the study and; and

Whereas, Green City Council would prefer to consider the study and plan in a forum that is more amenable to public comment and participation than the current circumstances will allow, and City Council and the Mayor would prefer to have the discussion after Fire Station Number 3 is complete and the economic impact of COVID-19 to the City budget is somewhat better understood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council hereby extends the deadline for presentation of the administration's Emergency Services Study and Plan to Green City Council until September 8, 2020.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall

take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
