A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIDSTATES RECREATION FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT MODIFICATIONS AND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF SYNTHETIC PLAYGROUND TURF AT PATRIOT PLAYGROUND, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Patriot Playground was installed in 2015 by Midstates Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department has consulted with Professional Playground Inspections LLC and Midstates Recreation and have determined Patriot Playground requires modifications to equipment and replacement of the safety surface; and

WHEREAS, PlayPower, Inc. has participated in a public bid process through Sourcewell and has been awarded a contract for playground components and safety surfacing. Contract No.010521-LTS (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, Midstates Recreation is an authorized partner/distributor of PlayPower, Inc. (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the City of Green Parks and Recreation Board supports the recommendation of the Service Department to make necessary playground equipment modifications and the installation of synthetic turf.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Midstates Recreation for the modification of playground equipment and the purchase and installation of synthetic playground turf, in an amount not to exceed Ninety-Six Thousand Six-Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-Seven Cents (\$96,618.77), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "C" with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said agreement and not substantially adverse to the City, and any necessary related documents.

SECTION TWO:

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 9.48 of the Ohio Revised Code. This purchase is permitted through a joint purchasing program: Sourcewell Contract No.010521-LTS, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payments to Midstates Recreation through the established purchase order procedure.

SECTION FOUR:

From the initial project budget (2024-R72 Exhibit "D"), the remaining balance for the project is Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$48,000). The revised estimate is Eighty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$87,835.25). The Finance Director is authorized to

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appropriate the sum of Forty-Eight Thousand Six Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-Seven Cents (\$48,618.77), which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency to the Patriot Playground Resurfacing Account (Acct. #402-7310-53631) from the unappropriated balance of the Parks Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
