A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH EMH&T, INC., FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM COMMENCING DECEMBER 1, 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City routinely contracts for various types of engineering services with multiple firms; and

WHEREAS, as a result of passage of Ordinance 2010-04, it is necessary for Green City Council to approve the hiring of engineering firms for the services; and

WHEREAS, the City is best able to consider, plan, design, and construct projects when it has a multiple number of firms available to choose from for the desired services; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to the quality-based selection process in the Ohio Revised Code, routinely hires a consulting engineering firm for a three (3) year term to provide engineering services for roadway, intersection, and roundabout design; environmental services; coordination of private utilities and other services set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into similar agreements with other firms providing engineering and related services for a three (3) year term pursuant to written agreements which are readily available to inspect and review in the office of the City Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the Engineering Department to enter into a contract with EMH&T, Inc. for professional engineering services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to EMH&T, Inc. for services provided through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
