Council:

What is Republic defining as yard waste? I am currently able to put leaves in a bag(s) or in the container and it will be picked up. I am also able to throw small limbs and sticks into the container as long they are a certain length. Will that no longer be acceptable with Republic and will Kimble still accept it?

Please confirm that the total increase in rate is more than \$1.30 (current rate +increase). This may confuse some since it will be closer to a \$3-\$4 increase overall.

I was on Council when Green agreed to approve a single hauler for the City and again when the contract was awarded to Kimble. The single hauler issue was controversial because everyone wanted to be able to choose their hauler. As a result, we had at least 3-5 different pick up services running different routes at different times every day. A single hauler would simplify the City schedule and reduce wear and tear on the roads.

Republic had the majority of the households on single contract but there were a lot of complaints. That was the major reason there was concern that a change needed to be made. The change to Kimble was questioned by Council even though they were lowest bidder because they were not local (based in the Canton area), a fairly new company in the area, would they be able to handle the increase in routes with the equipment they had or if problems popped up in their other areas would Green be the red headed step child and be last to get attention.

Kimble rose to the occasion and invested a lot of money on equipment and drivers and the rest is history.

I have never had a problem nor have I heard any overwhelming amounts of complaints. Customer service is wonderful and pick up service is outstanding.

Cities strive to seek out quality vendors who perform above and beyond not just for a single year but year after year. Kimble has done just that.

I understand competitive business and the government bidding process. This works fine for salt, asphalt, toilet paper and light bulbs. When you're bidding for service it should be different. The past track record of the vendor should be taken into account and weigh heavily in the decision. Customer service is very important as well as turn around time resolving complaints and/or concerns. In this case, Kimble is outstanding.

If Green starts to switch from longtime vendors who have performed well year after year, project after project for only the simple reason another company bids lower we will be searching for vendors who will want to even bid our jobs. There comes a time that the bottom line shouldn't be the nickels, dimes, and dollars. Our years long working relationships with engineering firms and consulting agencies will be at risk for those who choose to undercut just to get the business. Get the contract then we'll figure out how to do it!! Worse yet, there may be fewer bids for City work because we will be forced to take the

lowest bid no exceptions and vendors will choose not to risk accepting a contract that could be terminated in a short period of time.

Corners will be cut to avoid a situation when the fear would be if another vendor under bids our current vendor who knows the account and work history with the City, has relationships with the Administration and the public the fear would be just that - how do we avoid losing a trusted vendor and start from scratch building a working relationship only to realize that in a short period of time the process would start all over!

I understand there are legal concerns with a contract bid that must be considered to avoid litigation. I have no doubt that if Council is of the opinion that what they are hearing from those that are being served is important and needs to be considered that a solid, legal path can be created to make it happen.

To simple answer to your question is I am in favor to keep Kimble for at least another five years with an annual renewal for another 5 years until they fail to satisfy our criteria.

First, let me say thank you for wanting to get feedback from citizens regarding waste contracts before making a decision that affects us all. We appreciate that approach.

Regarding Kimble vs. Republic, we've been Green residents for 20 years, so we've been through different providers. One thing we like with Kimble is being able to set out additional bags with the can, and they take them. This doesn't happen often, but when it does it's a nice service.

We thought we read that recyclables would be picked up by Republic weekly, rather than every 2 weeks as with Kimble. This is something we're interested in, as we recycle a lot of items and sometimes forget which week we're on, which results in an overflow situation. Every week pickup would be ideal. So...points for Kimble, points for Republic.

Regarding cost, an additional small increase is ok, but we were a bit taken back when we saw the automatic increase that was going to be inevitable no matter which provider is used. Going from \$41.67 to \$53.85 is quite an increase, although we realize many services have gone or are going up in price.

If Republic picks up an additional bag or 2, and recycles weekly (and considering the slightly lower overall cost), we would be satisfied with making a change. We don't have a need for yard disposal.

While we love lower cost, lower cost without comparable service would not be our choice.

Green City Council is scheduled to vote to accept a new ten-year contract for our waste and recycling hauler on March 9th. The bids are in and our current hauler's bid (Kimble), is \$1.30/month higher than Republic, who was hauler before Kimble. Many in our community want us to keep Kimble despite the higher monthly cost citing superior service and prior performance issues with Republic .

An additional consideration is that with the acceptance of the new contract, residents will no longer be permitted to throw yard waste away with their trash. Kimble submitted its bid with an optional subscription service for an additional monthly fee for a yard waste cart which would provide a solution for residents who do not want, or can't, mulch, compost, or take yard waste to the city's recycling center. Dear Green Resident,

Green City Council is scheduled to vote to accept a new ten-year contract for our waste and recycling hauler on March 9th. The bids are in and our current hauler's bid (Kimble), is \$1.30/month higher than Republic, who was hauler before Kimble. Many in our community want us to keep Kimble despite the higher monthly cost citing superior service and prior performance issues with Republic .

An additional consideration is that with the acceptance of the new contract, residents will no longer be permitted to throw yard waste away with their trash. Kimble submitted its bid with an optional subscription service for an additional monthly fee for a yard waste cart which would provide a solution for residents who do not want, or can't, mulch, compost, or take yard waste to the city's recycling center. Republic's bid does not offer an optional yard waste service.

As chair of the committee considering this legislation, I'm seeking additional input from our residents and asking you to send your comments to our Clerk of Council at council@cityofgreen.org.

At this point in time, I understand that costs will increase, and that makes sense. However, I am more confused on the topic of what is considered "trash". I understand that the County and State indicate certain items that should not be considered waste, like Paint, Construction debris as well as hazardous materials etc. However, yard waste wouldn't fall into that. Understandably clippings can often be chopped up into bits to "disappear" over the lawn, but what about the leaves, weeds, fall and spring cleanup. That being said where does it start and where does it stop? One could say that a substantial amount of yard waste could be created during the growing season for valid reasons. Oftentimes this waste is much larger than my normal half bin of household trash.

It is noteworthy to try to direct people to the Recycling Center However, I feel that trying to get to the center during operating hours is a burden as well as the physical ability to move it into a container and then transport it to the center involves additional truck and trailer to carry this which is unreasonable.

If yard trash is not considered part of the weekly pickup, then why have the service? We should simply open up all service companies to the City of Green. It feels like council/purchasing missed the mark on what residents need, and that is the most disappointing part of it all.

I've worked with both vendors, and each has its own pros and cons, but I want unlimited trash pickup. I'm willing to pay for additional bins. I do not want to pay by the bag or have to acquire proprietary bags for this. Kimble was fair, but gaps in this purchase process seems to expose residents to the opportunity for fleecing or the additional "Yard Service fees" and the definition of trash.

This sounds like it needs another round of RFPs.
