A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SEEK SERVICES FOR THE OVERSIGHT OF THE FINAL RESTORATION OF THE NEXUS PIPELINE, WITH FUNDS APPROPRIATED FROM THE PIPELINE SETTLEMENT FUND, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2018-R09 authorized the Mayor to enter into a Settlement Agreement related to the Nexus Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the Nexus Pipeline is in the final stages of restoration; and

WHEREAS, it is prudent to monitor the process through its completion; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds to pay for the monitoring services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to contract with already approved professional services for the monitoring services to oversee the final stages of the Nexus Pipeline restoration process.

SECTION TWO:

The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the total sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to the Contracted Services Account (acct #245-4000-52412), from the unappropriated balance of the Pipeline Settlement Fund. These expenses will be paid from the NEXUS Settlement monies the City received.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
