A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO KARVO COMPANIES INC FOR THE 2020 RESURFACING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a "Notice to Bidders" in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, January 16, 2020; and, Thursday, January 23, 2020, for the 2020 Resurfacing Project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on Friday, January 31, 2020, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Karvo Companies, Inc. as the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project in the amount of One Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars and Fifty-Three Cents (\$1,885,648.53).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Karvo Companies, Inc. with its total base bid of One Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars

and Fifty-Three Cents (\$1,885,648.53) is the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Karvo Companies, Inc. for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Karvo Companies, Inc. through the established purchase order procedure.

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the Project may proceed immediately and forthwith. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
