Hello. My name is Margaret Yeager and I live in Ward 3. I was unable to attend the March 12th meeting regarding the discussion for a fire station in the southwest section of Green. I wanted to reach out to you and ask you to please do everything in your power to make this possible.

We called an ambulance a few years ago in the middle of the night for my son who was having trouble breathing. It took the ambulance roughly 10 minutes to reach our house. It felt like an eternity. Fortunately my son was alright, but that response time sure shook me. That could be way too long for others or even us again in the future. I had reached out to the fire chief at the time and he explained that was the best they could do with what they had.

This fire station is a must for this section of the city. Not only because of the pipeline (which is also running through a Dominion natural gas storage field in this section of the city-with some very old well heads and pipelines), but for anyone in need of these services at anytime.

Please, I ask that you do everything you can to make this happen.

I was confused about whether there was consideration for an actual additional station or a smaller (I think called satellite station) version of an actual station?
