A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE POLICING CONTRACT (FISCAL YEARS 2024-2026) WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF TO INCLUDE FLOCK SAFETY CAMERAS TO ENHANCE SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in April 2024, the City approved Resolution 2024-17A, entering into a first amendment to the policing contract to include Flock Safety cameras in the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, it has been deemed in the best interest of the public's health, safety, and welfare to continue to include Flock Safety cameras in the City of Green; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes and approves the Second Amendment to the Policing Contract between the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff. A copy of the Flock Safety reimbursement agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein to this legislation as **amended** Exhibit "A."

SECTION TWO:

The Finance Director is authorized to make necessary payments to Summit County as outlined in the Reimbursement Agreement.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
