INTRODUCED: FEBRUARY 22, 2022 ASSIGNED TO:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RAIN-DROP FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF THE CENTRAL PARK SPLASH PAD SAFETY SURFACE AND A NEW WATER SPRAY FEATURE, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Central Park Splash Pad is in need of a replacement outdoor safety surface and the replacement of a new water spray feature; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department has reviewed options for safety surfacing and believes the Life Floor product is the preferred safety surface. Life Floor is certified to NSF/ANSI/CAN 50 and meets six (6) unique performance-based standards; slip-resistance, impact absorption, chemical resistance, UV resistance, cleanability, and impermeability; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green Parks and Recreation Board supports the recommendation from the Service Department to Green City Council to appropriate the funds necessary to complete this Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Rain-Drop for the replacement and installation of the Central Park Splash Pad surface and a new spray water feature, in the amount not to exceed Seventy-Three Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-One Dollars and Seventy-Seven Cents (\$73,461.77), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 210.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Green. This purchase is in accordance with Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract No. 010521, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B", and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION THREE:

The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the sum of Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred Eight Dollars (\$80,808.00) to the Splash Pad Upgrades Account (Acct #402-7115-53643) from the unappropriated balance of the Parks Capital Reserve Fund. Green City Council further authorizes the Finance Director to make payments through the established purchase order process.

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SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FIVE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the need for this Project is immediate. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
