The Director of Finance shall notify Green City Council within three (3) business days of the transfer of all future City accounts from current financial institutions to any new financial institutions.

Any other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed to the extent of a conflict and all ordinances not amended by this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
