A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) PIERCE VELOCITY 100 FOOT HEAVY DUTY AERIAL PLATFORM TRUCK FROM ATLANTIC EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR USE BY THE CITY OF GREEN'S FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City is in need of replacing the current Ladder truck, 1919, used to fight fires and make rescues; and

WHEREAS, the City authorizes the purchase of one (1) Pierce Velocity 100 ft Heavy Duty Aerial Platform truck from Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc., pursuant to pricing through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Atlantic Emergency Solutions pursuant to pricing under the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, for the purchase of one (1) Pierce Velocity 100 ft Heavy Duty Aerial Platform truck, in a prepaid amount not to exceed, One Million Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars (\$1,264,379.00) which is a discount of Thirty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars (\$38,958.00) from the unit price of the Pierce Aerial which is One Million Three Hundred Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Seven Dollars (\$1,303,337.00), if the City prepays within fifteen (15) days before contract signing, a copy is attached hereto and incorporated herein as **AMENDED** Exhibit "A". **The City is authorized to purchase a performance bond in the amount of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (\$3,834.00).**

SECTION TWO:

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 210.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Green. This purchase is being made in accordance with the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program under Contract No. 022818-PMI and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason

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that the need for this equipment is immediate. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
