A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH ONSOLVE (“CODERED”) TO PROVIDE AN EMERGENCY MASS NOTIFICATION SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green wishes to enter in into a three-year (3) Service Agreement with Onsolve for their CodeRED emergency mass notification system for use by our safety services for telephone, text messaging, and emailing alerts during an emergency or severe weather event, as well as, community text and email alerts for community engagement and awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a three-year (3) Agreement between the City of Green and Onsolve for its CodeRED emergency mass notification.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to Onsolve through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason the services required are necessary immediately to assess the ongoing approval process. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
