**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT GROUP, LLC. FOR PAVEMENT EVALUATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City desires to perform the pavement evaluation on 171 miles of payment in the City utilizing the Pavement Management System; and

WHEREAS, Pavement Management Group, LLC., desires to perform the pavement evaluation for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract with Pavement Management Group, LLC., for these services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Pavement Management Group, LLC., a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A", for pavement evaluation services for the City.

**SECTION TWO:**

City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to Pavement Management Group, LLC., for services provided through the established purchase order process.

**SECTION THREE:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FOUR:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that this work may begin immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
