A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO PURCHASE A PIERCE VELOCITY HDR PUMPER (HEAVY RESCUE), MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Fire Division's current Heavy Rescue truck (1993 chassis and 1995 Marion rescue body) has reached the end of life of its safe, useful service as a frontline emergency response vehicle and needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Division has unsuccessfully applied for the Rescue truck to be replaced via an Assistance to Fire Fighters Grant each year since 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City has unencumbered money available in the Ambulance Billing and Pipeline Settlement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Pierce Velocity Pumper is available through Atlantic Emergency Solutions Inc. with contract pricing through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Alliance (Contract #113021-OKC-1, maturity date 2/10/2026) for one million one hundred sixty thousand five hundred and sixty-six dollars (\$1,160,566.00, as attached hereto and incorporated herein to this legislation as Exhibit "A."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Atlantic Emergency Solutions, Inc. for the purchase of a Pierce Velocity HDR Pumper for use as a Heavy Rescue emergency response apparatus.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes an appropriation of eight hundred eighty-one thousand five hundred ninety-two dollars (\$881,592.00) to the Heavy Rescue Truck Account (Acct# 245-4000-53651) from the unappropriated balance of the Pipeline Settlement Fund and two hundred seventy-eight thousand nine hundred seventy-four dollars (\$278,974.00) to the Heavy Rescue Truck Account (Acct# 218-3220-53654) from the unappropriated balance of the Ambulance Transportation Fund. Green City Council authorizes and directs the Finance Director to make payment to the Vendors through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that this is an appropriation of money. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
