A RESOLUTION AWARDDING A CONTRACT TO SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR THE TOROK CENTER PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, February 17, 2022; and, Thursday, February 24, 2022 for the Torok Center Pavement Maintenance Project (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on Friday, March 4, 2022, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the Contract be awarded to Specialized Construction Inc. as the lowest and best bidder for the Project in the amount of Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$57,683.50).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on March 04, 2022:

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Specialized Construction Inc. with its total bid of Fifty-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$57,683.50), is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the sum of Eight Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Eighty-Five Cents (\$8,451.85) to the Torok Center Pavement Maintenance Project Account (Acct. #402-7300-53630) from the unappropriated balance of the Parks Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION FOUR:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with Specialized Construction Inc. for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Specialized Construction Inc. through the established purchase order procedure.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the Project may proceed immediately and forthwith. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
