A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PARKS DIVISION EQUIPMENT SURPLUS PROPERTY, NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO DONATE THE SURPLUS PROPERTY TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green has surplus property which is no longer needed for any municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the surplus property has been determined to have a value of approximately less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in scrap value; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires to donate the surplus property to the Summit County Agricultural Society; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Agricultural Society desires to accept the donation of the surplus property from the City of Green.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council determines the following property is hereby declared surplus property which is no longer needed for any municipal purpose and authorizes the donation of the same to the Summit County Agricultural Society:

- a) Manure Spreader
- b) Hay Bailer

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the surplus property may be donated as soon as possible. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
