A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT ("STBG") FUND PROGRAMMED BY THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY ("AMATS") FOR THE GREENSBURG ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT (PROJECT) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ASSIGNED TO:

WHEREAS the City of Green has identified that the Greensburg Road Resurfacing Project is eligible for funding through the Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program; and

WHEREAS Greensburg Road represents an important thoroughfare within the City of Green; and

WHEREAS the City has identified that Greensburg Road between Lauby Road and the east corporate limit should be resurfaced; and

WHEREAS, if requested funds are granted, the City of Green shall be responsible for at least twenty percent (20%) of the eligible cost; and

WHEREAS the City is requesting \$520,000.00 in STBG funds; and

WHEREAS the current estimated total project cost is \$700,000.00; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the Mayor to apply for and sign all required agreements and documentation necessary for Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Funds programmed by Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following Project:

Project Name: Greensburg Road Resurfacing Project

Project Description: Greensburg Road Resurfacing (Milling & Fill w/ Repairs)
Project Termini: Greensburg Road – Lauby Road to East Corporate Limit

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green acknowledges and understands the AMATS 2025 STBG Guidance and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the project application is accurate, that it tends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any

deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law. It is an emergency to ensure that we comply with the guidelines for submission of the Project for a Grant.
