Charging Station Letter of Intent

We appreciate the recent conference call with Courtney Freyhauf, our NOPEC Community Outreach Manager regarding the many services that NOPEC can provide a member community. The City of Green is interested in the community cell charging station, however, there has been a waiting list. Ms. Freyhauf informed us on the call that a charging station is now available. We would like to pursue obtaining the available cell phone charging station. We will need to have City Council approval on the intended agreement. However, we cannot introduce new legislation until January of 2021, because our City Council sessions have concluded for the year.
