A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM NOPEC, INC. FOR AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE CHARGING STATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, NOPEC, Inc. hereby grants all equipment, components, and parts necessary for UNIT electronic device charging station(s) (“Charging Station”) to the City of Green (“Grantee”) in accordance with NOPEC Policy. The Charging Station will contain the NOPEC logo and NOPEC marketing. By executing this Grant Agreement, the City of Green authorizes the use and display of NOPEC’s logo and marketing on the Charging Station for as long as the Charging Station is used; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green shall be solely responsible for the installation of the Charging Station, at the City of Green’s cost and expense. Further, the City of Green shall be responsible for any and all operation of, and maintenance required for, the Charging Station and for payment of all electricity used by the Charging Station. In the event that the City of Green does not or cannot install or use the Charging Station, the City of Green shall immediately notify NOPEC in writing and return the Charging Station to NOPEC; and

WHEREAS, the NOPEC, Inc. Locker Style charging station will be located within Central Park, 1795 Steese Road, Green, Ohio, near the Splash Pad feature; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires to participate in the Grant Program developed by Summit County and administrated by Greater Akron Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds to participate in the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council supports accepting the NOPEC, Inc. Grant for an Electronic Device Charging Station to be installed at Central Park, 1795 Steese Road, Green, Ohio.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter into the Grant Agreement between the City of Green and NOPEC, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the installation of the Electronic Device Charging Station for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
