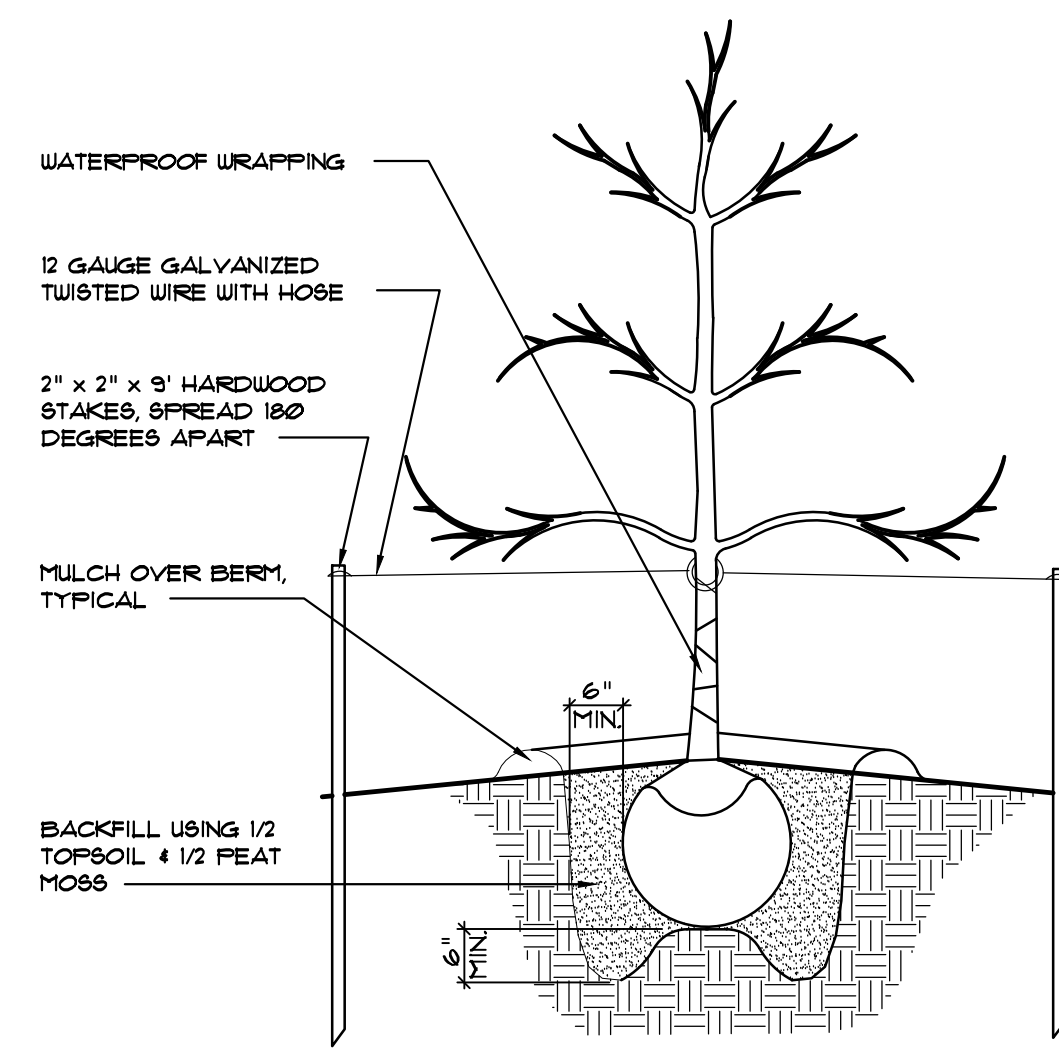
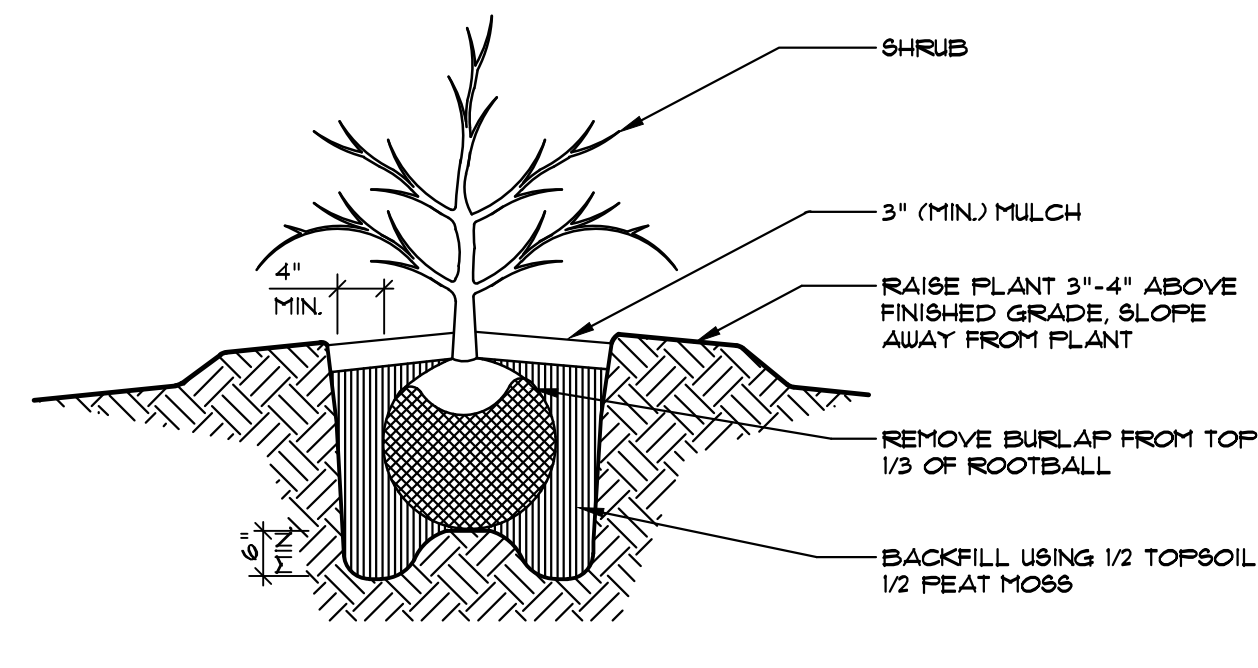

 Littleleaf boxwood is an evergreen shrub in the Buxaceae (boxwood) family and native to Japan. Buxus is the Latin name for boxwood or box tree. The common name of boxwood refers to the wood used to make carved decorative boxes. Another etymology is that boxwood describes the square stems of its young plants.

A beautiful addition to the landscape in semi-shaded mixed shrub borders, or as a background shrub, or hedge plant.

This tree offers nice contrast when planted along with pink or red dogwoods with larger evergreens in the background.

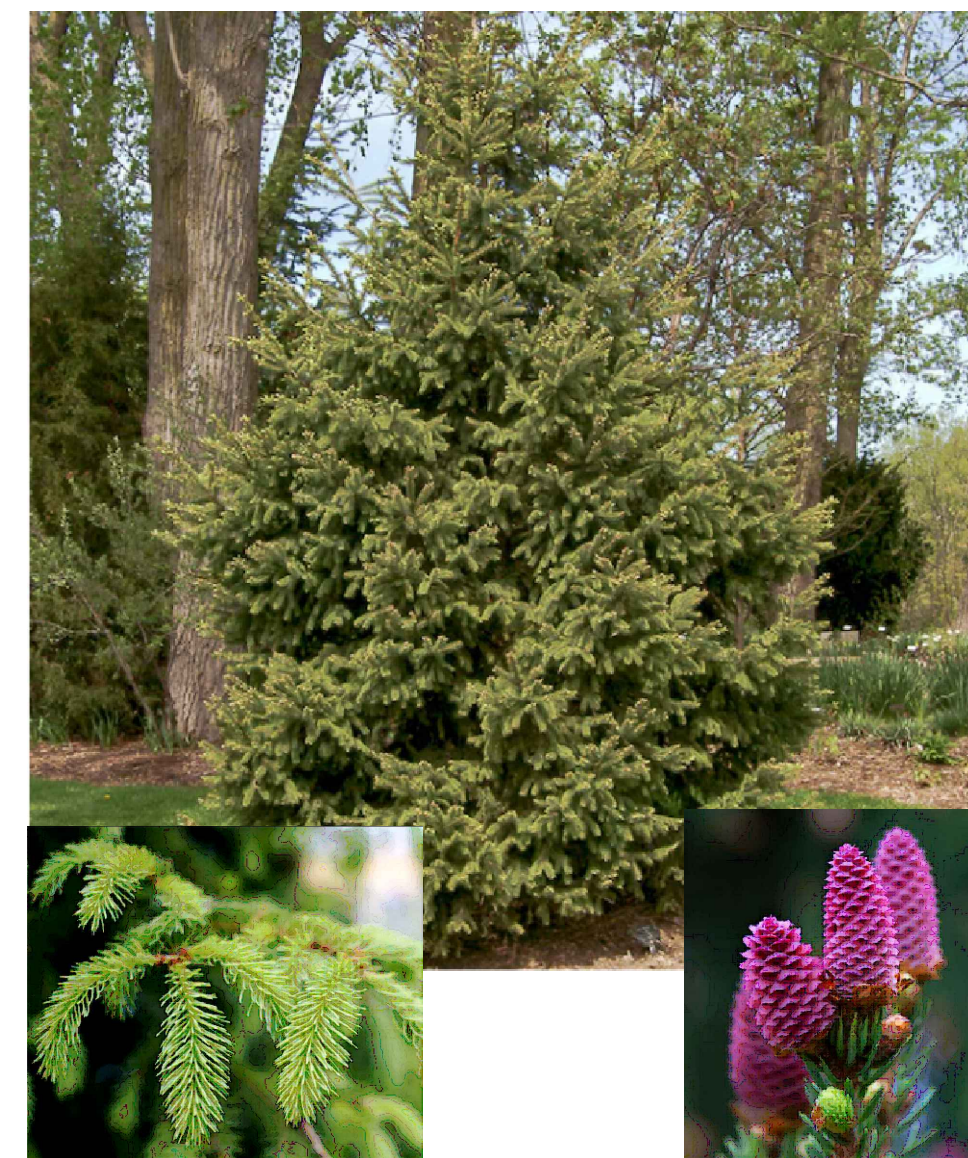

Foliage is held on the trees later into fall than with most cultivars. A superb choice as a high profile shade tree for larger landscapes. Deciduous.

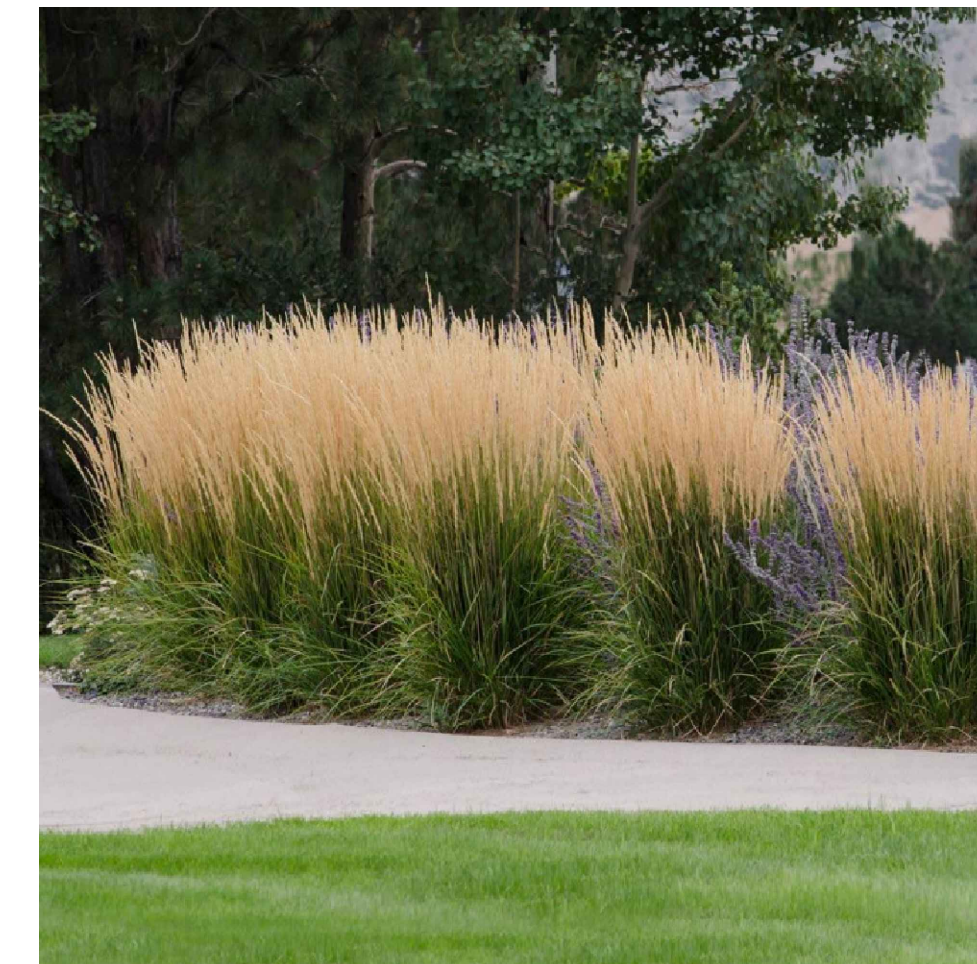
DESCRIPTION:

Its twisted texture on the pyramidal form tolerates shearing nicely for a more tailored column. Cold hardy and reliable. Ideal as matched pairs or planted in multiples for an attractive screen. Evergreen.

Makes a pretty evergreen background for contrasting foliage colors, flowering shrubs or to highlight a fall leaf show in trees and shrubs. Line them up into a windbreak or incorporate into a wider shelterbelt. Good sound barrier along busy streets.

 Creates a stunning vertical effect with feathery stalks that emerge reddish brown in spring and turn a rich golden color in fall. Blooms two to three weeks earlier than common feather reed grass. Thrives in wet soils, yet tolerates drier conditions. Stalks make great cut flowers. Sterile seeds do not produce unwanted seedlings.
