A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2018-R67 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CITY OF GREEN'S DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO DISPOSE OF UNNEEDED EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY BY SALE TO EMPLOYEES, PUBLIC AUCTION, OR ON EBAY, PURSUANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green adopted Resolution 2018-R67 on September 25, 2018, authorizing the Director of Public Service to dispose of unneeded equipment/property by sale; and

WHEREAS, although intended to be part of the original auction, a 2000 Chevrolet Truck, GMT-400 K3500, was inadvertently left out of the auction list; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2018, the 2000 Chevrolet Truck was sold at the public auction; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2018-R67 and Exhibit "A" should read to include the inventory of the 2000 Chevrolet Truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council directs and authorizes the Director of Public Service to include the 2000 Chevrolet Truck, GMT-400-K3500, to be included in the inventory on the Auction List, a copy is attached as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
