## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2020 5 TON KENWORTH T370 CAB AND CHASSIS FROM HISSONG KENWORTH OF RICHFIELD FOR USE BY THE CITY'S SERVICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City of Green needs a new 5 Ton snow plow chassis to maintain its streets; and

WHEREAS, the City authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2020 5 Ton Kenworth T370 Snow Plow Cab and Chassis from Hissong Kenworth of Richfield, pursuant to pricing through the Sourcewell Purchasing Program, the City of Green's Membership Number #43084.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

## **SECTION ONE:**

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Hissong Kenworth of Richfield Purchasing Program for the purchase of one (1) 2020 5 Ton Kenworth T370 Cab and Chassis, Snow Plow Chassis, in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Six Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Seven Dollars (\$86,287.00), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

#### **SECTION TWO:**

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 210.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Green. This purchase is in accordance with the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Contract No. 081716 - KTC and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

#### **SECTION THREE:**

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payments to Hissong Kenworth of Richfield through the established purchase order procedure.

## **SECTION FOUR:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

## **SECTION FIVE:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the need for this equipment is immediate. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (¾ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
