A RESOLUTION AMENDING ADOPTED RESOLUTION 2020-R53 TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF GREEN TO DISPOSE OF UNNEEDED VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT BY SALE VIA ONLINE AUCTION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 721.15 OF THE REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2020, Green City Council adopted Resolution 2020-R53 to authorize the City of Green to dispose of unneeded vehicles and equipment by sale via online auction, pursuant to Section 721.15 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Green City Council directed and authorized the Director of Public Service to identify the equipment to be auctioned by the City. A list of the equipment to be sold was attached as Exhibit "A." However, Exhibit "A", Number 3, had a typographical error in the auction list. One of the Vehicle Identification Number's ("VIN") that recently sold via the online auction was not correct. An amended copy of Exhibit "A" with the corrected VIN is attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

On August 15, 2020, Green City Council adopted Resolution 2020-R53 to authorize the City of Green to dispose of unneeded vehicles and equipment by sale via online auction, pursuant to Section 721.15 of the Revised Code. Exhibit "A", Number 3, had a typographical error in the auction list. One of the Vehicle Identification Number's ("VIN") that recently sold via the online auction was not correct. An amended copy of Exhibit "A" with the corrected VIN is attached.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
