WHEREAS, in promotion of the public interest of the residents of the City of Green, it is necessary for the City to appropriate for street purposes certain fee simple interests and easements in and to various premises to facilitate construction and implementation, altogether with the necessary appurtenances to be further identified as the Massillon Road at Boettler Road & Corporate Woods Roundabouts Project "(Project"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 719.05, only one reading of this Resolution shall be required.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

# **SECTION ONE:**

Green City Council deems it necessary and declares its intention to appropriate for street purposes certain fee simple interests and easements in various premises more fully described as follows:

Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
