HERE ARE COMMENTS FOR THE PUBLIC REPORT.

8-Dec-20

I am Tony Ziehler; my address is 3883 Golden Wood Way.

I want to state publicly during the 8-December 2020 Green City Council meeting my thoughts concerning Council's discussion of the 2021 Operating and Capital budgets during the 24-November 2020 Council meeting.

I heard Council and the Administration state the following:

- The master plan for the Parks will not be completed until sometime in the first quarter of 2021 &
- The fall 2019 draft of the Master Trail Plan is the latest version of the City's concept for "connectivity trails" &
- Spending the Pipeline Settlement Fund needs to have a "safety" benefit.

I ask Council to do the following:

1. Do not spend any of the Pipeline Settlement Fund on the Willadale Trail until
 - Council discusses and approves the City's "connectivity trail" plan,
 - Council considers all of the recommendations of the Pipeline Settlement Fund Advisory Committee.
2. Do not fund the Master Plan Park Upgrades until the City reveals to you and the public the master plan for the Parks.
