A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH THE SUMMIT COUNTY SHERIFF TO PROVIDE POLICING SERVICES WITHIN THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the existing contract between the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff's Office for policing services expires on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff have engaged in substantial discussions regarding a new Contract for a three (3) year term, commencing January 1, 2021 and expiring on December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the public's health, safety and welfare to continue the relationship between the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff for policing services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes and approves the new three (3) year Contract between the City of Green and the Summit County Sheriff for the term commencing January 1, 2021 and expiring on December 31, 2023. A copy of the new Policing Contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that it may be effective as of January 1, 2021. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
