A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS WITH VARIOUS ENGINEERING, CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, AND TESTING COMPANIES FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2023 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City routinely contracts for various types of engineering services with multiple firms; and

WHEREAS, as a result of passage of Ordinance 2010-04, it is necessary for City Council to approve the hiring of engineering firms to provide professional services to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City is best able to consider, plan, design, and construct projects when it has a multiple number of firms available to choose from for the desired services; and

WHEREAS, the City, pursuant to the quality-based selection process in the Ohio Revised Code, routinely hires a consulting engineering firm for a three (3) year term and is in the process of renewing the contract with an engineering firm for those services; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into similar agreements with other firms providing engineering and related services for a three (3) year term pursuant to written agreements which are readily available to inspect and review in the office of the City Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

City Council authorizes the Engineering Department to enter into a contract or contracts with the following firms for the services specified:

SECTION TWO:

City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment to the various engineering firms for services provided through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the reason that services may be necessary immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
