**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR A PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE PROJECT, LOCATED IN THE CITY OF GREEN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the public interest of the City of Green requires the regular maintenance of roadways located in the City, and the City intends to perform routine and regular maintenance of its roadways, including pavement markings, in 2019 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project's cost, (the "Project's Cost") is estimated at approximately One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Fifty-Five Cents (\$153,496.55), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Summit County and the City desire to enter into an Agreement, to confirm the Project's Cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of competitive bidding and the City as the lead agency for performance of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Green City Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, the Mayor is authorized to enter into the Agreement with the County of Summit which is necessary and in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the County of Summit, through the County Executive, on behalf of the Summit County Engineer, for the 2019 Project.

**SECTION TWO:**

The terms of said agreement shall include the following:

- a. The parties estimate the Project's Cost to be approximately One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Fifty-Five Cents (\$153,496.55); and
- b. The net estimated cost to the City shall be an amount not to exceed the budget amount of One Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Six Dollars (\$168,846.00); and
- c. The City shall provide all other financial resources necessary to fully complete the Project.

**SECTION THREE:**

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and

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relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FOUR:**

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason to permit the Project to proceed immediately. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ( $\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
