

Sarah Richard's said at Coucil mtg 3/13

On Thursday, March 9, the Citizens For Responsible Green Government, turned in 71 petitions containing approximately 1,509 signatures in support of the referendum to place the Nexus settlement on the ballot. Over the course of just 3 1/2 weeks this turned out to be the most successful signature-gathering drive for a referendum in Green's history.

Now that you have the petitions, Under the law, the city is suppose to hold the petitions for 10 days and then forward them to the Board Of Elections to validate the signatures. Should any protests be lodged over administrative versus legislative, we are confident that the settlement is a legislative matter because the settlement agreement provides for the acquisition of land by Green. The agreement does not implement an existing law.

On behalf of 1,509 Green residents, we hope that you do not object to the voices of your residents and that you would allow the settlement to be decided by the voters. You will have an opportunity to convince voters that your settlement is worth adopting or not. The people will keep fighting until all of the people are heard and we will not forget who has denied us the chance to ask questions and be heard. It is extremely unfair that anyone should have go to these to have their concerns heard on a matter that will undoubtedly change Green forever.
