A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OR ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AS ADMINISTERED BY THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE HISTORIC LICHTENWALTER SCHOOLHOUSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation of the historic Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse promotes the preservation of the distinctive character of the City of Green; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation of the historic Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse will safeguard the architectural integrity of this designated local landmark; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation of the historic Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse fosters civic pride and protects the story of the City's past through educational programming and historic preservation awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and execute all associated documents necessary to participate in the CDBG Grant Fund programmed by the County of Summit Department of Planning & Economic Development for the rehabilitation of the historic Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council acknowledges and understands the historic Lichtenwalter Schoolhouse Rehabilitation Project meets one or more of the Community Development Block Grant Program 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan Goals and no local share is required.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it
