A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) TANKER PUMPER FROM FINLEY FIRE EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR USE BY THE CITY'S FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City is in need of replacing Tanker Pumper 1918 used to fight fires and shuttle water; and

WHEREAS, the City authorizes the purchase of one (1) Tanker Pumper from Finley Fire Equipment Company, pursuant to pricing through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a purchase agreement with Finley Fire Equipment Company pursuant to pricing under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program, for the purchase of one (1) Tanker Pumper, in a prepaid amount not to exceed Six Hundred Forty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Two Dollars (\$643,972.00), which is a discount of Twenty Six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Two Dollars (\$26,632.00) from the unit price of the Tanker Pumper of Six Hundred Seventy Thousand Six Hundred Four Dollars (\$670,604.00), if the City prepays within fifteen (15) days before contract signing, as is more fully set forth in the quotation attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

The requirement for competitive bidding is waived pursuant to Section 210.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Green. This purchase is being made in accordance with the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program under Contract No. 800180 and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and for the further reason that the need for this equipment is immediate. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and

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be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
