A RESOLUTION AWARDED A CONTRACT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE 2022 RESURFACING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green advertised a “Notice to Bidders” in the Akron Beacon Journal on Thursday, February 10, 2022; and, Thursday, February 17, 2022, for the 2022 Resurfacing Project (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on Friday, February 25, 2022, the City Engineer opened bids for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the remaining bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Northstar Asphalt, Inc. as the lowest and best bidder for the Project in the amount of One Million Seven Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$1,766,450.25).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City received and opened the following bids on February 25, 2022:

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council finds, based on all relevant factors, that Northstar Asphalt, Inc. with its total Base Bid & Alternate No. 1 & 2 of One Million Seven Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$1,766,450.25), is the lowest and best bidder for the Project and agrees to comply with all specifications.

SECTION THREE:

The Administration seeks to reduce the typical ten percent (10%) contingency to two and half percent (2.5%) of the awarded contract for the 2022 Resurfacing Project.

SECTION FOUR:

The Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Northstar Asphalt, Inc. for the Project. The Finance Director is authorized to make payments to Northstar Asphalt, Inc. through the established purchase order procedure.

SECTION FIVE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION SIX:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the Project may proceed immediately and forthwith. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
