Good Afternoon

I'm emailing you this morning to let you know that I've arranged a meeting with our city officials and local business owners on Massillon Rd with regards to upcoming, 3 year construction project that's scheduled to begin in 2022.

If you are unaware, the City of Green is planning to convert a total of 5 the following intersections into roundabouts. These intersections consist of the following.

Boettler Road & Massillon
Corporate Woods & Massillon
Raber & Massillon
Massillon & Stine
619 & Massillon.

To convert these intersections will take approximately 36 months to complete and traffic will obviously be severely impacted.

Having spoke to other businesses who have gone through recent projects construction, loss of revenue caused by this has been significant.

At the meeting, Mayor Neugebauer will be on hand to clear up exactly what's going on, why the city feels it's necessary to have five roundabouts within a mile radius and what can be done to protect our business.

I've also extended invitations to our city council and other business owners who have experienced what we're about to go through.
