A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR THE CLEAN OHIO TRAIL FUND MANAGED BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR THE DESIGN & CONSTRUCTION OF WILLADALE TRAIL LOCATED WITHIN AND ADJACENT TO BOETTLER PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF) program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Green desires financial assistance under the Clean Ohio Trails Fund Program,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE:

1. The Mayor is authorized to file an application for financial assistance and enter into a grant agreement.
2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.
3. The Mayor does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Clean Ohio Trail Fund Program.

SECTION TWO:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION THREE:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Green and so that the deadline can be met. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
