A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COVENTRY TOWNSHIP, SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CITY OF GREEN'S WASTE HAULING CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES OF OHIO HAULING, LLC., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Green ("Green") entered into a five (5) year Contract with Republic Services for waste hauling and recycling services in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Contract was effective as of April 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the prices in the Contract were obtained through competitive bidding pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 9.48 allows a political subdivision to permit one or more other political subdivisions to participate in Contracts that were competitively bid for the acquisition of services; and

WHEREAS, Green agrees to permit Coventry Township, Summit County, Ohio, to participate in the Green Waste Hauling Contract with Republic Services of Ohio Hauling, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes Coventry Township, Summit County, Ohio to participate in the Green Waste Hauling Contract with Republic Services of Ohio Hauling LLC. In order to participate in the Green Waste Hauling Contract, Coventry Township shall adopt a Resolution confirming that Coventry Township will be bound by the terms and conditions found in the Green Waste Hauling Contract and states that Coventry Township residents shall pay Republic Services directly for waste hauling services provided in Coventry Township.

SECTION TWO:

This Resolution is not intended to place Green in privity of Contract with either Coventry Township or Republic Services with respect to their Agreement.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberation of this Council and any other Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
