A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GREEN’S SERVICE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS’ COMPENSATION, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation use the Safety Intervention Grant to partner with Ohio employers to minimize injuries from manually washing large vehicles and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds are available to employers for projects which substantially reduce or eliminate the risk of workplace injuries and illnesses; and

WHEREAS, the Service Department desires to apply for the available Safety Intervention Grant Fund in the amount of Twenty-Three Thousand One Hundred Twenty-One Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$23,121.75) for the purchase of an automated-vehicle cleaning system for the Service Department. The City’s contributing share will be Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Seven Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$7,707.25), for a total project cost of Thirty-Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$30,829.00); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds to pay for the cost of the services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREEN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

Green City Council authorizes the City of Green’s Administration to submit a Grant Application to the Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Safety Intervention Grant Program. Council further authorizes the acceptance of the grant if awarded.

SECTION TWO:

Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to appropriate Thirty-Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars (\$30,829.00) to the South Annex Equipment Account (Acct #100-7400-53640) from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund. Green City Council authorizes the Finance Director to make payment for the equipment through the established purchase order process.

SECTION THREE:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meeting of this Council and any deliberations of this City and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION FOUR:

Green City Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Green. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$ ths) of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
