WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bids and recommends the contract be awarded to Karvo Companies as the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project in the amount of \$1,194,810.45.

SECTION ONE:

The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate the total sum of Two Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Seven Dollars (\$226,367.00) Three Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Dollars (\$328,940.00) to the 619/Pickle Road Intersection Account (Acct#203-2100-53634) from the unappropriated balance of the Permissive License Tax Fund, and make payments to Karvo Companies through the established purchase order procedures.

SECTION FOUR:

The City of Green finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
